Mrs. Bullock-Sinkler was a member of the 109<sup>th</sup> Transportation Unit that was stationed at Baghram Airfield in Afghanistan. I ask that you remember her parents, who are Randolph Thompson and Jackie Bullock, and her husband, who is Douglas Sinkler in your thoughts and prayers. Furthermore, I ask that you remember all of the members of the military who are serving in harms way.
