

YARD WASTE PICKUP GUIDELINES

Waste Management will pick up yard waste from Town of Chadbourn residents when it is prepared in the following manner:

- Set out ONE (1) pile rather than several small piles.
- Limbs and branches shall be NO greater than five inches (5”) in diameter & NO more than five feet (5’) in length.
- The TOTAL amount of yard waste collected each week shall be limited to 5’x5’x5’ in size.
- Yard waste in excess of a 5’x5’x5’ pile will be left until the next service day.

It’s that time of year again...

- **During the Fall Leaf Season** - Separate leaves and grass clippings from larger branches and limbs. Place leaves and grass clippings in loose piles for utilization of vacuum collection equipment. **DO NOT BAG LEAVES.**
- **Do not** set out yard waste near guide wires, power lines, poles, mailboxes, vehicles or other objects that impede pickup.
- **Do not** pile yard waste at storm drains to prevent clogging.
- **Do not** set out yard waste generated by commercial contractors. Residents and/or private contractors are responsible for pickup.
- **Do not** set out bulky goods, such as appliances and furniture, as they are not included in the City’s service.
